

At this meeting we will vote on the 2018 Church budget and elect our 2018 Church Council.






HANGING OF THE GREENS

FLASH BACK...SERVICE GUILD 1954

February 25, 1954

A meeting of the Church Council, Ladies of The Church and Mr. Schantz, from the Organ Company was held Thursday, February 25-1954 at 4 P.M. in the church. \$912.50 was the down payment on the \$9125.00 organ. A motion was made by Geo. Arps and seconded by Helen Murphy to install the console in choir loft and the organ in the balcony. There are several extra items of installation, \$90.00 for cable, to be paid by the Ladies of the Church, \$200.00 for carpenter work in the balcony, \$150.00 for airline, \$100.00 for electrical work, \$200.00 to be paid by Church Council and remaining \$250.00 by Ladies of the Church. The old organ was taken out Tuesday, February 16, 1954.




