

From The Lastor's Len

Brothers and Sisters in Christ -

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

In St. Paul's letter to the Philippians he begins his greeting with the following:

"I thank my God every time I remember you, constantly praying with joy in every one of my prayers for all of you, because of your sharing in the gospel from the first day until now. I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work among you will bring it to completion by the day of Jesus Christ. It is right for me to think this way about all of you, because you hold me in your heart, for all of you share in God's grace with me, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel. For God is my witness, how I long for all of you with the compassion of Christ Jesus. And this is my prayer, that your love may overflow more and more."

Yes, St. Paul and Timothy understood the love between Pastor and Congregation. St. Paul and Timothy understood the relationship that grows when you live with one another, laugh together, cry together, celebrate together, grieve together, pray together and worship together. I have never felt that love more acutely and deeply than I did on May 13<sup>th</sup> when this community of faith celebrated with the family and me the celebration of my 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Ordination. I was surprised, I was overwhelmed with emotion, and I was thankful for your love, your generosity, and your joy. I find myself still emotional when I think about that celebration, the joyous worship, the amazing food, the laughter and the celebration. Thank you to everyone who worked so hard to make the day possible, for working quietly so I didn't know, and for each of you for the thoroughness of the celebration. THANK YOU.

I also want to thank you for being you and for accepting me. It's not every pastor who walks around with 80 pounds of advertisement by his side showing the world that they aren't perfect. It's not every congregation who would look upon a Pastor and his Service Dog and truly see them as the team, welcome them both into their lives, homes, hospital rooms – I know, I know – you welcome Guinness and allow me to come along at the end of the leash, but let's not tell the Bishop that – he doesn't need to know just how much better Guinness is at this pastoral stuff than I am.

You, the people of St. Paul's – you, the Church Council – you the Confirmation students – you the Bible Study folks have helped me in my healing tremendously. Your gentleness and understanding, your encouragement to take care of myself, your love and compassion when mom died. You are a true blessing in your ministry to your pastor, their family, and this community.

It's hard to believe that I have been a Pastor for 25 years, it's hard to believe that we have walked together for the past 11 years. It is an amazing journey, lead by Christ and empowered by the Holy Spirit. I believe that we are just getting started on this journey of faith – that God is calling us to be more present with one another, with our parish and neighborhoods, and in our walk of faith.


