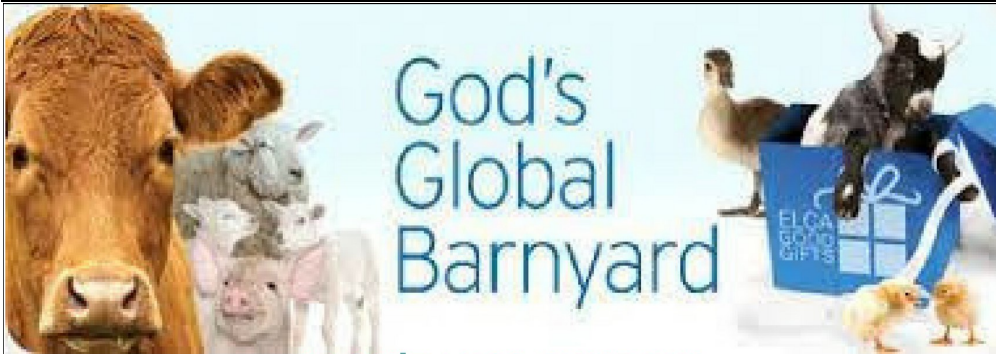

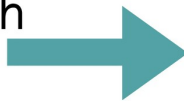

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ.

It's been a whirlwind, it's moved fast, before you know it folks will be closing up lake houses, school will be back in session and Buckeye/Wolverine/Crimson Tide/Wildcat football will be filling our Saturday afternoons!

Fall will bring about some visible work around St. Paul's as well as Sunday School and Choir will be starting back up, worship times will move, Catechism will be underway, youth programs will ramp back up to full speed, and overall activities will start to hum. As I sit to write this I am honestly a bit overwhelmed. Then somewhere, in the midst of the chaos that surrounds and fills me I hear the still small voice of God reminding me that God is the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end. I remember that God is unchanging and in control. In those moments of chaos it is Christ who stills the storm.

Remember, at Creation God spoke his Living Word (Jesus) into the chaos and brought about order. Remember it is Christ who walked across the storm tossed waves and spoke peace to his disciples. If God can speak Christ into primordial chaos, if Christ can calm even the wind and the waves, how much more can Christ bring peace to our lives. In the midst of the change, of the chaos, of hectic schedules, stay anchored to Christ's cross, for His love is never changing. Thanks be to God.

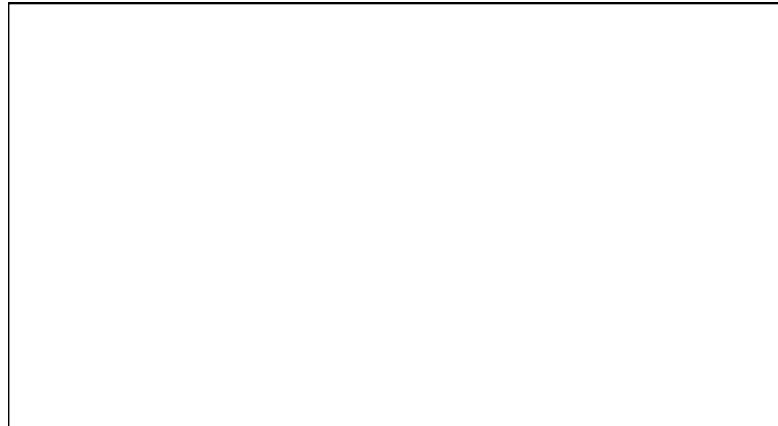
