Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

As I said at the beginning of Pastor Tamara Wood's funeral. "The date of Easter is determined by an ancient formula that has not changed in centuries. Easter shall be on The First Sunday, following the First Full Moon, following the Vernal Equinox." That means that there are years that Easter is very early on the calendar and years that Easter is very late on the calendar. This year Easter is about as late as it can be given that ancient formula. Easter 2019 will be April 21st. Since Easter is the movable Feast and everything else flows from Easter that means that Ash Wednesday will not be until the 6th of March and that Pentecost will not be until the 9th of June.

That ancient formula has a big impact on our planning and calendars. This means this year that the Bishop's Bible Study will begin on March 10th, and since Pentecost is not until after school is out, that Council in consultation with families has decided to move Confirmation Sunday to May 19th – which is the Fifth Sunday of Easter and not at the Feast of Pentecost as is the tradition at St. Paul's. Please note this is a ONE TIME movement of Confirmation and will be revisited every time that the Festival of Pentecost comes at such a late time in the calendar year.

Also, at the Annual Meeting it was decided by the congregation that Easter Worship will be ONE FESTIVAL SERVICE at our normal 10:15 Worship Time. Breakfast will begin at 9:00 AM followed by our Easter Festival Worship Service.

I would like to give a huge thank you to Jim Ehlinger, Shirley Keller, and Bill Parker for their service to our congregation on Congregation Council this past year. If you were at the Annual Meeting you will know that we had a very good year – attendance was down a bit because it ONLY SNOWS ON SATURDAY – but our giving was very good and we were able to finish the year in the black. Give yourselves a huge round of applause for that, it is rare in this day and age. Also, our membership grew this past year and looks to grow again this year as many new families have expressed an interest in joining SPLC.

A big welcome to the 2019 Council: President Jason Frederick, President Elect Ryan Mack, Treasurer Lori Brandt, Secretary Stacy Barker, Trustee Dick Burk, Stewardship Andrea Wardinski, Outreach Jenna Pauley. We look forward to a great 2019 as we move towards our 150th Anniversary in 2020.

With the weather outside I am tempted to close by saying, "That's the news from Lake Wobegon" but instead let me say – Please stay warm and safe. God loves you and so do I.
