I am late writing my newsletter article – again! This seems to be a more common occurrence the last few years, I am not sure if it is due to the fact that I am getting older or if I am running out of things to say. Don't laugh! Actually, I think maybe this is because I am learning that *chronos* – the time of a ticking clock isn't as important as a *kairos* – the time that God acts. I found that to be true more often than not lately. When a missed dentist appointment on a Tuesday morning, opens the door for me to be available at an event that has forever changed our city. When a missed exit on 24 gives an opportunity to get a call from a friend who needed prayer. *Kairos* – that moment of opportunity when the Hand of God presents us with a gift of presence, a gift of witness, a gift of hospitality.

The late writing of this months newsletter means that as I was reading my news this morning I saw a report that Jim Boeheim, the head basketball coach at Syracuse University struck and killed a man walking alongside the road while he was driving home from coaching The Orange. This wasn't an event caused by alcohol or speed. When asked, Coach Boeheim said through his attorney, "I did not see him. I just did not see him in the dark walking on the shoulder of the road."

"I did not see him" - That phrase, let it play over in your mind, let it play over in your heart. "I did not see him" Did it sink in? How many of us are guilty of not seeing another person? How many of our hearts ache because we don't feel seen? I know that I am guilty of looking at a person and not seeing them, truly seeing them. I know that it aches when I feel that someone does not see me.

We talk a lot about God's love – we talk a lot about God's presence – we talk a lot about God being with us. However, let's be honest, there is no love, no presence, no walking with if God doesn't first see us! God sees YOU as you are. God sees you with hurt and heartache, God sees you with pride and jealousy, God sees you as both Saint and Sinner. God sees you and I so that we can see!

Looking at the different definitions of see I ran across this:

- to see with the eyes
- to see with the mind, to perceive, know
- to see, i.e. become acquainted with by experience, to experience
- to see, to look to
 - to take heed
 - to care for
- I was seen, showed myself, appeared

Look at the way God sees us and calls us to see. Eyes, mind, perception, know, experience, care for.

This Lent we are going to be looking at the gifts of the senses – how does God see, hear, taste, touch, and smell his creation – and how has God gifted us to use our senses to experience God's love. Join us in the Lenten journey.

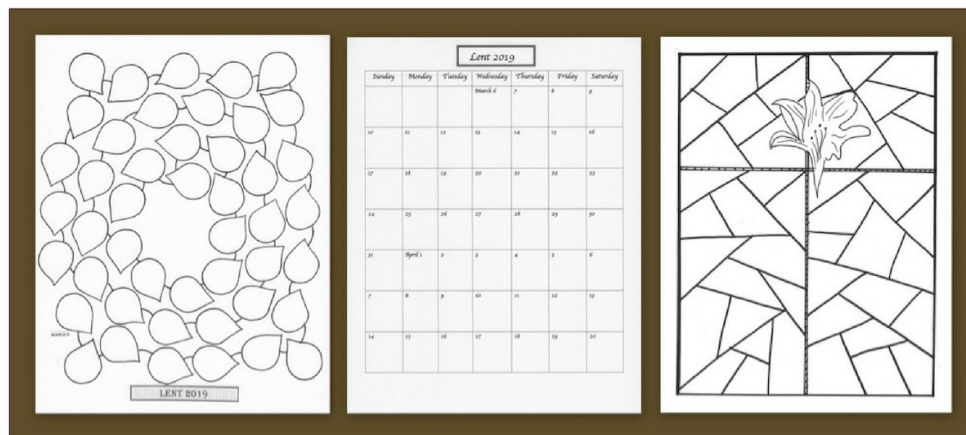

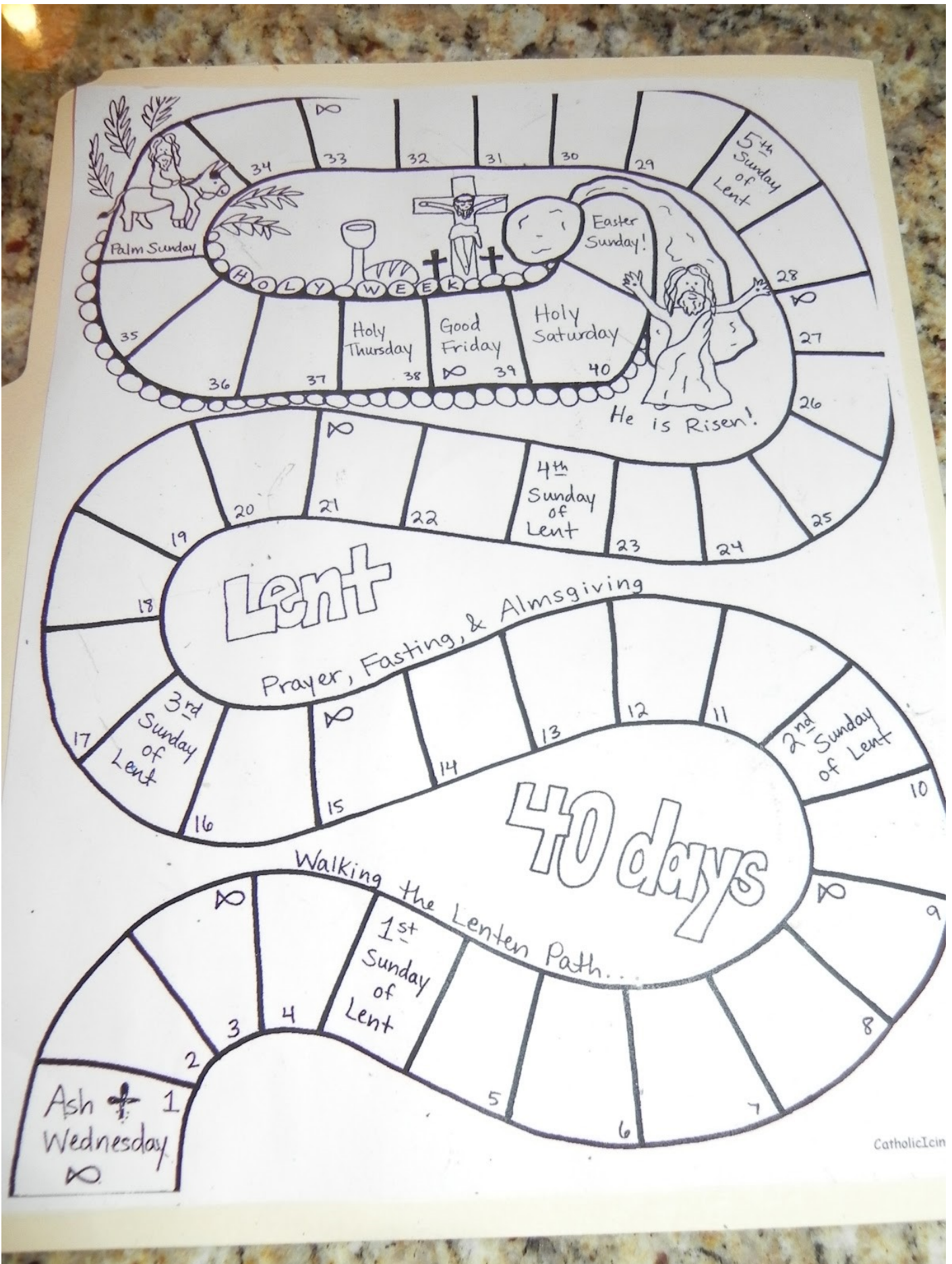
