From The Lastor's Len

June – July 2019

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace be to you and peace from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ, Amen.

As you can imagine, I have been thinking a lot about St. Paul's and our 150th Anniversary. Looking back at the history, being formed by returning Civil War soldiers from the 38th Ohio Infantry and the 108th Ohio Infantry. Veterans who wanted a place to worship free of the criticism for belonging to The Masonic Lodge. Remembering our history and the importance of The Mason's for caring for widows and orphans and providing for disabled soldiers long before the invent of the VA and of casualty payments by the government. The history of this place, of this historic house of worship is linked directly to the War Between the States.

As I was reflecting on this reality today I thought about my Great-Great-Great Grandfather Silas Turley. A Civil War veteran who road with 34th Virginia Cavalry, I remember standing barefooted on the 150th Anniversary of Gettysburg on land that he would have fought on that decisive July day. Silas was eventually captured and sent to Illinois as a Prisoner. It's interesting, a Civil War Veteran, a survivor of Gettysburg, a prisoner, a blacksmith. I would have loved to listen to his stories, shared his wisdom and known him. However, in a way I am him. He passed down his genetic lineage to John Franklin – to my grandfather Howard Clifton – then to my mother Betty Ann – then to me.



I love history – I love tinkering with my ancestry tree to see what helped shape me. I find it fascinating that Silas didn't include any of his history on his tombstone, buried a couple of hundred yards away from my mother. A simple statement of faith and his birth and death date. I do find it interesting in the picture are yellow, something passed down to the family to me today – I love yellow.

History fascinates me, enamors me sometimes overwhelms me. However, from what I know of family lore, Silas spoke little of the war – he would say, "That's yesterday, what matters is today." Maybe the reason he violated the conditions of his release as a POW and returned to his home in southern West Virginia – or maybe he had a bit of a oppositional personality. Hmmm... wonder where I get that from?

I pray in the months to come we will celebrate our history. I pray we will remember our past – those good old days that we long for and cling to. I pray we remember that for our children and our grandchildren that worship in this historic place, THESE are the good old days. May we look at our past, the joys and sorrows. May we remember the spirit of those brave "yankee" (you knew I had to throw that in somewhere) veterans that built this House of Worship. May we remember the history of faith that has been passed down to us – but may we never forget Silas Turley's wisdom as well, "That's yesterday, what matters is today. May I add as we discuss faith – what also matters is that we pass down what has been handed to us. Faith, Hope, Love, and Grace.




