#### 2. Pastor's Report

a. Review of Upcoming Events:

    - We still need volunteers to help run the video-audio boards during services.
    - We are in need of new personal microphones. Jason will talk with Ron Huner and have him start pricing mic options. Discussed having 10 mics available for special performances would be ideal.
    - New Members We have several new families attending worship that are not yet members. Pastor Dave will give membership forms to some council members and announce in service that anyone who is interested to please see council for a membership form.
    - Funerals at St. Paul's have become much more frequent and take a toll on Pastor Dave. Following funerals please be understanding if Pastor Dave is not as present as recovery time is needed.
    - Pastor Dave will be leaving for his Ireland trip on July 10, 2019.
    - Since arriving at St. Paul's on April 30, 2007, we have had 84 Baptisms and 93 Funerals within the congregation.

  - b. High School Youth continue to meet on Wednesday nights. Younger groups have concluded for the summer. Youth were happy to participate in the Easter Breakfast and the Blessing of the Badges event. Thank you goes out to Suzi McBride for singing the National Anthem at the event.
  - c. Tent Revival take place July 25, 26, 27. Save the Date! Plans are underway with the city. We need an insurance rider as we have in the past years. Jason will make a call.
  - d. Deacon News:

- -We are having a meeting for all Communion Set Up and Servers to orient all to how we will use the silver communion ware since it is a bit confusing. We invite anyone to come and serve in this way. Even if you don't want to serve, this class will add meaning to Holy Communion. Meeting is May 30<sup>th</sup> at 6:30.
  - We have a need for new Confirmation Robes by next year. We will try to get the ones we have dry cleaned to see if any are salvageable. Our class is larger next year with a couple smaller youth and the available robes are larger.
  - We need to order minor things like new white gloves (stripping of the altar) and a new pall.

The goal of the community area is to provide a modern, cohesive, warm, welcoming environment for members and visitors alike, to encourage God's family to sit, relax, and talk in God's house. In addition to the transformation of the classrooms, we will work on other steps toward welcoming visiting families into our St. Paul Family, such as welcome brochures placed in the pews that introduce our staff and ministries. Funding options and stages of the transformation were discussed. Congregation is asked to keep an eye out for information in the coming months as plans progress.




